

Licensing of the HDClone Product Family

Products from the HDClone product family are available under the following license types.

HDClone Free Edition Private Freeware License¹⁾ (free Download)

HDClone Basic Edition Private Workplace License¹⁾ (Online-Shop)

HDClone Standard Edition Workplace License (Online-Shop) Volume License (Online-Shop)

Types of Licenses

The license types named above cover different scopes of use as described below.

Freeware License

A Freeware Licenses allows to use the product free of charge²⁾ on arbitrary computers.

Single License

A Single License allows for firm installation and permanent use²⁾ of the product on one (1) computer belonging to the licensee.

Workplace License

A Workplace License allows for firm installation and permanent use²⁾ of the product on up to two (2) of the licensee's computers, for example on one PC and one laptop.

Technician License

A Technician License allows one (1) licensee (service technician) to use the product in two ways:

- Firm installation and permanent use²⁾ of the product on up to two (2) of the licensee's computers, for example on one PC and one laptop.
- Use on arbitrary PCs for servicing and maintenance purposes performed by the licensee by using the provided token(s). The software can optionally be firmly installed on each of these PCs, yet a token must be connected while it is being run.

Volume License

A Volume License allows firm installation and permanent use²⁾ of the product on a specific number of PCs in accordance with the volume³⁾ granted for the particular license.

Maintenance License

Allows for use on arbitrary PCs for servicing and maintenance purposes performed by the licensee by using the provided token(s). The software can optionally be firmly installed on each of these PCs, yet a token must be connected while it is being run.

¹⁾ Private Licenses encompass the same scope of use, while being limited to non-business use only.

²⁾ For time-limited licenses, this only applies for the validity period, which may be extended upon expiration.

³⁾ The volume can be selected upon the purchase of a Volume License.
